Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Annual College Ski Trip is a highly anticipated and extremely enjoyable event offered each year at Holy Cross College. The Ski Trip is open to all students in Years 7-10. In recent years the trip has been enormously popular and with limited spots available it is important to return permission slips with payment as soon as possible to ensure your son's acceptance for the trip.

To secure your son's position on the Ski Trip you need to complete the attached forms (payment and medical) and submit for approval **by Friday May 26**. Your son's application will be reviewed and if accepted your son will be allowed to attend the Ski Trip. If not accepted, your payment will be refunded. Once your son has committed to the ski trip and payment has been made there will be NO refunds.

Student safety is of the highest priority on the trip, with all students subject to a number of requirements to ensure this. Prior to participation in any snow sport activity all students are thoroughly briefed and prepared. As well as this students participate in mandatory lessons whilst on the snow which cater for their ability level. The lessons will be conducted by qualified ski and snowboard instructors and conducted in groups organised according to the experience and ability of each student.

#### The details for the trip are as follows:

Depart HCC:	Friday August 4 at 1:30pm.
Ski Dates:	Saturday August 5 and Sunday August 6
Arrive back at HCC:	Sunday August 6 at 11pm (approximately).
Cost:	\$720

#### Cost includes:

- Return transport to Jindabyne and the ski fields each day.
- Two nights accommodation at Bungarra Alpine Centre – Jindabyne.
- All meals whilst at the lodge. Please note students will be required to purchase any food on the bus trip to and from Jindabyne.
- Hot lunch at Thredbo each day.
- Two day lift pass at Thredbo.
- Three group lessons at Thredbo of two hour duration.
- Two day Ski hire, including helmet (snowboard hire at an extra cost of \$20).
- Two day national park entry fee.
- Two day pass to Thredbo indoor heated pool.

Please note that costs are based on a minimum number of students attending and therefore subject to change should these numbers not be met.
