Dear Parents/Guardians

We spoke with you at the Year 11/2018 Parent Information evening regarding the forthcoming **compulsory** Year 11/2018 Parent/Student Subject Selection Interviews to be held in the Cardinal Gilroy Library on **Wednesday afternoon 6 September**. I write to you now with details of the process that you and your son need to attend to in preparation for that meeting.

You will find with this letter a Senior School Commitment. Please read over this carefully with your son, sign it and bring it with you to the interview on Wednesday 6 September. This statement is indeed a *re-commitment* to the culture and values of Holy Cross which you and your son undertook to support on initial enrolment into the College. It is important that at this important junction in your son's education we re-state and re-emphasise the values and standards for which the College strives and which we call on parents and their sons to support.

On the afternoon/evening of your interview, your son has been asked to take you through to the Cardinal Gilroy Library where Mr Sean Craven (Year 10 Coordinator) will issue your son's Subject Counselling Document indicating his subject selections. Details of these selections will also be emailed to your son on Monday 4 September. You will then be assigned to an interviewer.

I hope that the recent Parent Information Night and the accompanying process to assist your son in determining his pattern of study (2018-2019) proves helpful in discerning your son's educational needs for the coming two years.
