Year 10 students are now entering an important time in their education, where for the first time they will be able to select elective courses that they wish to study in Years 11 and 12.

I am writing to inform you that the Year 11 2019 Parent/Student Course Preference Information Night is fast approaching. The details are as follows:

Date: Tuesday, 8 May 2018

Time: 6.00pm – 8.00pm

Place: Flexible Learning Precinct & Patrician Centenary Hall

This is a compulsory night for all Year 10 students and their parents/caregivers, and students will need to wear their full school uniform.

The evening will commence with a Course Preference Information Expo from **6.00pm - 6.50pm** in The Flexible Learning Precinct where parents and students can meet with the Leaders of Learning for each subject area to ask questions and/or seek clarification on elective subject choices for 2019.

Following the *Information Expo*, an information session will occur in the Patrician Centenary Hall commencing at **7.00pm - 7.45pm**, where Mr Stewart and Mr Reid will outline the requirements of the importance of Stage 5 study.

Your son will receive the *Year 11 2019 Course Preference Information Handbook* in the first week of Term 2 and should use the information in the book, as well as any questions/information at the Information Expo, as guide to what subjects to be studied in Year 11 and 12.

On **Wednesday 25 July 2018**, you will be invited to the College for an interview with your son to discuss his Course Preferences for next year. As part of the process of enrolment into Year 11 2019 a commitment from families will be required in the form of a *Senior Student Statement of Enrolment Understanding*. A further letter will be sent home regarding this interview and Statement of Entitlement Understanding prior to the 25 July 2018.

This is a most significant time of discernment for your son and more broadly for you as a family. Be assured of our best efforts to assist you in determining the best choices for your son.
